

Free plastic* washers with every litre of milk

(*conditions apply)

There's life in the old used milk container after all, and I'm sure we've all made/are making use of them:

- liquid containers
- boxes
- trays
- lazy man's thread chasing
- plastic washers

to name but a few



I needed a couple of plastic washers for my router-skid table. In this case, 25mm by 6.25mm for the stop-guides.



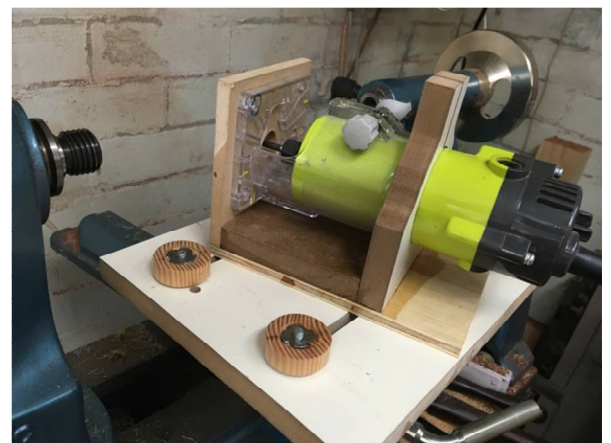
I cut some 30 x 30mm squares, made an MDF/plastic sandwich using masking tape to hold it together and drilled a 6.25mm hole in the centre.



Because of the internal diameter, I was able to use my pen mandrel together with some larger bushes to clamp the sandwich together while I turned the washers down to the desired diameter.
